- 3. How do you aspire to, and hopefully achieve, some measure of moment by moment intimacy with Jesus?
- 4. All of us have a number of scenarios or areas of influence in which our lives are lived out. Identify your areas and think of times when you have let Christ work through you or have missed your chance. How can you improve your success rate?
- 5. Read 2 Cor. 12 vs9-10. How does our 'weakness' give Christ greater opportunity to shine through our lives in real life situations?
