This morning we begin an exciting new two-term series entitled

Holy Spirit: Person, Presence, Power.

Thirdly we want to see people once and for all set free from patterns of sin and addiction by his power.

And finally we want to demonstrate the power of the Spirit as we witness to a world lost without Christ.

And please remember that a key objective of this series, to slightly misquote John Wimber, is not just to learn the stuff, but get acquainted with doing it as well. May God lead us by the hand and by his Spirit as we embark on these things together.
