As we enter into a new year and hopefully begin to think about emerging from the COVID pandemic, the book of **Nehemiah** provides us with a great template for how we should respond. Nehemiah had to square up to challenges far greater than ours.

Judah was possibly at the lowest point in its entire history. Much of the nation was in exile in Babylon. The walls of Jerusalem were deliberately broken down. It was a monumental mess. And Nehemiah who enjoyed a very responsible post as cupbearer to the king (responsible for his safety as well as his wellbeing) could have decided that this was not his problem and that he preferred to live a quiet life.



But he didn't. Instead, he listened carefully to the facts as they were presented to him. He responded emotionally to the loss that had clearly taken place. He prayed and fasted as a direct result of that loss. And then he acted in response to a trust in God's provision for the future.

We need to do the same. Which is why our **21 days of prayer and fasting** beginning on Monday (17th January) are so important. A chance to seek God as to how he wants us to 'rebuild the walls' of Jubilee Church.
