### **Introduction**

We are focussed in this study in chapters 1-6. But don't worry I'm not expecting you to read all six but instead dip in and read relevant sections.

**1. Read Joshua 1 v 1-9**

- 2.** Summarise what instructions God is giving Joshua in order to be successful in taking the promise land.
- 3.** God is very keen to encourage and build up Joshua, How might we as Christians take encouragement from this text?

**4. Read Joshua 2 v 1, 8-11**

Why do you think God chose Rahab a prostitute?

The information Rahab passes onto the spies on the roof dramatically effects the battle of Jericho discuss!

**Read Joshua 5 v 13-15**

- 5.** Why do you think God sent a celestial messenger to see Joshua?

- 6.** Why did the messenger ask Joshua to take his shoes off?

**Read Joshua 6 v 15-20**

- 7.** What does the battle of Jericho tell us about our faith and obedience in God?
- 8.** What does the battle of Jericho teach us about perseverance?
