Bags of food continues to be busy, with new clients being referred quite regularly.

There are plans afoot to improve our storage, thanks to a grant from Spelthorne Council. This will involve replacing the shed with something more substantial and will enable us to support more families in a more efficient way. Exciting times! Please pray that we would have wisdom and compassion and be a real blessing to many.

In January we were able to support those displaced by the flooding, not just with food, but by becoming a hub for warm clothes and bedding. There were many families at the traveller site who had to leave everything behind in the middle of the night to move to hard standing on sheep walk. Thier clothes, toys, freezers etc. Were all ruined. One lady was about to have to have a baby, so we were able to provide emergency supplies, clothes, cot etc. for her.

It was lovely to see Shepperton folk spring into action to support them and to be a big part of the effort.
